IMPEACHMENT.

It has already been stated that a majority of the committee has made a report favoring the impeachment of the President. Two Republicans, one the Chairman of the committee, report against the whole scheme, in a very able argument from their stand point; and Judge Marshall and his Democratic colleague, also make a report adverse to impeachment.

The points made are that impeachment will only be for an "indictable offense," and that no such offense has been proved against the President; that there is nothing charged against him which would convict him in a court of criminal jurisdiction, for any offense now known to the law; and Congress cannot declare a law to be "high crime or misdemeanor," and then proceed to try the President for that offense.

The charges against the President are: I. "Obstruction of power and violation of law." II. "That the President has corruptedly used the public property of the United States." III. "That the President has corruptedly used the pardoning power."
