THE Poor House.—The Poor House Commissioners have purchased for the use of the poor of Bloom township, one hundred acres of land in Mount Pleasant township, owned by Rev. D. J. Waller's son. They have the pick of the land at \$125 per acre, which includes the buildings. The refusal of the remainder of the farm is granted, should it be made available to purchase it, for \$100 per acre.

ON the evening of the 12th of April, a child of James Rounseley residing in Hemlock township, was being addressed for bed, his clothing caught fire from a candle which had been placed on a table near by, and he was severely burned as to cause a death of the following morning. The opinion of the attending physician was, that excessive fright had been the main cause of death, as the burns though severe, might not have proved fatal.

THERE was a splendid display of the Aurora Borealis or Northern Lights on Sunday night the 15th. The flashes of light as visible here were possessed of little or no color, but in other localities they were of every tint of the rainbow. The air during the existence of the lights was so highly charged with electricity that the telegraph wires were worked without a battery and their end. This wonderful exhibition is supposed to forewarn of a storm, but as the rain fell in torrents on Saturday, the prophecy looks dubious as to the least.

SOME advocate setting strawberry plants in the fall; others in June, July, and still others in August. We believe the best time to set them is in the month of April or the first of May the better time. After many years' experience, we have no hesitation in saying that the best time in the whole year is the spring. The frequent and genial showers of that season are favorable to the growth of the plants; and they soon get hold so as to be able to withstand the heat of summer and the frosts of winter. When set in summer, unless frequently watered, the plants soon dry up and die. If set in the fall they are very likely to be thrown out and destroyed the following winter.

BLOOMSBURG, just at present is troubled with too much time, perhaps it were better to say too many times. The town clock, when in running order, has one hour which it proports noon; each of the Furnaces a separate and distinct time, differing from the clock; the Rail Road Co., another; each of the watermills one of his own, whilst everybody's watch goes its own gait, as if perfectly aware that its own hour can not be successfully disputed by any other. With the late lamented Ward, we ask "Why is this thus?" It certainly seems as if this could be changed and one time be determined upon to serve for all. There are people in town who daily eat their dinners at a little past eleven, firmly believing that it is high noon, and when in doing their duty by themselves and their country, it is all wrong as so necessary and acceptable a pleasure as dining should by no means be made a snare and a delusion. Therefore it is that we raise our voice and cry—"Let us have fewer times!" If absolutely necessary it would be better to call a township convention to regulate the matter, than to live in so utterly unsatisfactory a state of doubt.
