CONSTITUTION: ARTICLE I.—NAME: The name, style, and title of the Association shall be the Columbia County Co-operative Relief Association.

ARTICLE II.—OBJECT: The object of the Association shall be the relief of the poor and distressed of the County of Columbia, Pa.

ARTICLE III.—MEMBERSHIP: Sec. 1. The requisite qualifications for membership shall be that the applicant shall be a good health, able, and temperate man.

ARTICLE IV.—MANAGEMENT: The business of the Association shall be conducted by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE V.—FINANCE: In order to secure stability to the Association, there shall be raised a permanent fund.

ARTICLE VI.—DUTIES: All members shall be bound to pay their contributions to the Association.
