PROTECT THE BIRDS.—The Crowsley Center, Pa., has a large number of the southern counties in this State call upon all farmers, whether members of Granges or not, to join in protecting the insectivorous birds from destruction by men and boys from cities and villages, who wander over the fields and woods in every direction, shooting indiscriminately all kinds of birds and wild game, besides throwing down fences and stone walls, when these come in their way. Under the game laws of this State, no one has a right to enter premises of another, without his consent, for the purpose of shooting or killing, and it is to be hoped that the Grange organization may unite with the public generally in the laudable endeavor to protect farmers from the destruction of their feathered friends.
