THE STATE. From the very meagre returns received it is impossible to give the result in Pennsylvania. The city of Philadelphia gave 15,427 Republican majority, but William H. Wright, Democrat, was elected Sheriff by 6,233 majority over W. Elwood Rowan, Plirgin-Republican.

Large gains are reported for the Democrats in Michigan and in Massachusetts. Ohio is claimed by the Republicans by 8,600 majority; in 1872 Grant had over 41,000. A Republican majority of 17,900 is claimed in Maine but Blaine may have sent the dispatch.
