COLUMBIA COUNTY PRISON RULES. The following rules have been adopted by the County Commissioners for the government of the prison.

1. Persons shall be kept in separate cells, so far as practicable, and each prisoner shall be required to keep his person, and utensils perfectly clean and in perfect order.

2. No prisoner, or other person, shall be allowed to make pictures, drawings or sketches of any kind upon the walls, or in any manner to deface, mark or injure the walls, furniture or building in any of its parts.

3. No prisoner shall be allowed to have tobacco or scatter shells or dirt upon the floors or walls, either in cells or corridors, or commit any nuisance offensive to the most perfect cleanliness.

4. No person shall be allowed to have in his or her room any musical instrument, cards or other games of chance, nor shall be allowed to manufacture any article for their own benefit or profit.

5. Profane and obscene language is positively forbidden; nor shall any person indulge in profane, whistling, or unnecessary noise of any kind; nor shall they be permitted to have under any circumstances unless ordered by the attending physician.

6. All surplus food and waste of material must be carefully collected and handed out of the cell when called for by the keeper.
