THE SHAD.—The shad has been a mystery for years. He comes into the rivers in the spring in vast numbers, and soon departs to the ocean. His food is little known and his sea life is a mystery. The bulletin of the U. S. Fish Commission for 1881 contains a paper which throws some light upon the natural history and habits of the shad. The paper is founded upon the examination of the shad of Southern rivers, immediately after they leave the ocean. The microscope was called into use and revealed a remarkable state of affairs. The shad is toothless, and it has been a mystery how it lived. The naturalist of the Fish Commission found that there was attached to the alimentary canal a great number of cures, or blind sacs, which the vermiform appendix in man. These pockets vary from an inch to three inches in length, and number about 75 in each fish, it was ascertained that all these pockets were full of food when the fish entered the rivers. The theory is that these pockets are employed as magazines from time while in fresh water. The food was a sea-weed and the parasites were found to be undigested and intact. It may be possible to find the ocean home of the shad by the contents of its numerous food magazines. The fish are very interesting and very delicious. It is to be hoped that more of their life and history may be traced.

Death of Col. Levi L. Tate. Last Monday evening at about seven o'clock, Col. Levi L. Tate, for many years a resident of this town, and editor of the Columbia Democrat, died at his residence in Williamsport, after an illness of nearly four months, aged 72 years, 10 months and 7 days. The Gazette of Williamsport Tuesday gives the following brief sketch of his career: "Levi Lambert Tate was born in the town of Clearfield, Pa., June 23, 1810. His father, who was a Quaker, was a farmer in Clearfield county, and the subject of this sketch was his sixth son. At an early age he was apprenticed to the printing business in the office of the Pennsylvania Banner, Clearfield. After becoming a journeyman he followed the printer's trade, and worked for awhile in Harrisburg, where he was married, January 27, 1833. By this wife he had four children born to him, only one of whom is still living. On the 29th of July, 1838, he married his second wife, a Lycoming county lady, who survives him, together with four out of seven children.

His newspaper work. In January, 1855, he became a partner of W. L. Moore in the publication of the Pioneer & Banner, Clearfield. Shortly after this he became a partner of James McCracken in the publication of the Democrat and Republican, at Brookville, Jefferson county, Pa. He afterwards, during the course of his long and eventful life, became proprietor of the following newspapers: Berwick Standard, Berwick Enquirer, at Berwick, Pa.; Luzerne Democrat, Wilkes-Barre; Columbia Democrat, Bloomsburg; Luzerne Standard, (daily and weekly); Luzerne Standard, (Sun and weekly); Williamsport Standard, and lately the Luzerne Chronicle, which paper he owned at the time of his death, having been in the "editorial harness" over forty-eight years, his political faith being Democratic.

Holds positions of prominence. In 1839 he was appointed collector on the Pennsylvania canal, with office at Berwick, Columbia county, and during his occupancy of this position he published the Berwick Enquirer, at Berwick, and the Luzerne Union, at Wilkes-Barre. In 1861 he represented Columbia county in the lower house of the Pennsylvania legislature, and

was afterwards nominated for State Senator, but he withdrew, owing to a disruption in the Democratic party at the time. When the call for the emergency men was made, during the late war, he was among the first to step forward and proffer his services, which were accepted by the Government. He moved to Williamsport in 1867, and from that time up to his death, he took great interest in the First Presbyterian church, of which congregation he was a member.

Notice on Freezer's History. The Philadelphia Times of last Saturday contained a notice of the "History of Columbia county," which we print below.
