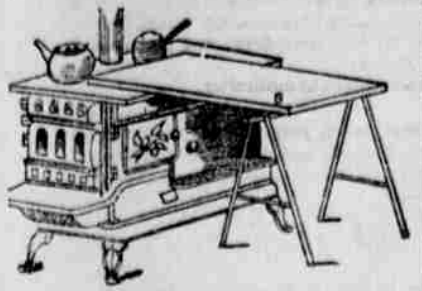


EVAPORATING FRUIT. A Much Better Method Than Outdoor Drying in the Sun.
