

Printing Postage Stamps.

On the 1st of July the government of the United States commenced printing its own postage stamps at the bureau of engraving and printing.

The question was finally carried to congress when the plan of the secretary of the treasury and the postmaster general was sustained.

This is a fact of interest to collectors. There is quite a quantity of the old stamps on hand, and the new ones will not be issued until they are needed.

The stamp collectors have cornered the \$1 stamps of the Columbian issue, and uncanceled ones are now worth \$10.—Press and Printer.
