NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that every person, excepting Justices of the Peace and Aldermen, Notaries Public and persons in military service of the state who shall hold, or shall within two months have held any office or appointment of profit or trust under the United States, or of this state, and city or corporate district, whether a subordinate office or otherwise a subordinate office or agent who is or shall be a subordinate officer or agent who is or shall be employed under the Legislative, Executive or Judiciary Department of this state or of any city or of any incorporated district, and also that every member of Congress and of the State Legislature, and of the Elector or Common Council of any city, or Commissioners of any incorporated district are by law incapable of holding or appointment of Judge, Inspector or Clerk of any election of this Commonwealth and that no Inspector, Judge or other officer of such election shall be then voted for.

The Inspectors and Judge of the election shall meet at the respective place appointed for holding the election in the district to which they respectively belong, before seven o'clock in the morning, and each of those Inspectors shall appoint one clerk, who shall be a qualified voter of such district.
