Daniel Decatur Emmett is Old Now and Poor.

This novelty once introduced, Mr. Emmett and his talents were in inordinate demand. Not only America, but England, wildly applauded him.

On Saturday night the manager having charge of Mr. Emmett's performances came to him and imperatively demanded a new "walk-around" for the following Monday night.
