ARE GAME WARDENS. Every Constable is a Fire, Fish and Game Warden, With Full Power to Enforce Laws.

Judge Ehrgood, of Lebanon county, in charge to the grand jury last week, upon its presentation of the regular court report, has brought to the attention of the authorities throughout the state the duty of constables as game and fish wardens.

"A few weeks ago a Luzerne county constable refused to act when called on, and he was tried and convicted. Constables can arrest without a warrant any person caught violating the game and fish laws.

"Constables receive, besides the regular fees, \$10 for every arrest and conviction of fish, fire or game offenders. Half is paid by the county, and the other half by the state.

During the summer season fishermen complain that the law is constantly being violated and now that the game season is open, complaints in regard to its evasion will soon follow.
