WASHINGTON.

Washington, Nov. 9, 1903. Democratic politicians here are pleased with the result of the elections. While the party did not succeed in defeating Senator Hanna in Ohio, it had a splendid victory in Maryland, where President Roosevelt's attitude on the race question formed the principal issue and in New York City it prevented the republicans, under the guise of Fusionists from retaining control of the city.
