GRANGERS AT SUNBURY.

Patrons of Husbandry will gather there rext December. The Pennsylvania Grange, Patrons of Husbandry, has appointed its annual meeting, to take place in Sunbury on the 12, 13, 14 and 15 of December. This is a great occasion with the Grangers and always draws together a great concourse of people from all parts of the State. Mr. C. H: Dildine, who occupies a prominent position in the Grange; and is a member of the executive committee, is now in Sunbury making preliminary arrangements for the annual gathering in that place, and ascertaining the extent of the accomodation which that city can furnish to the great number of people who will be there. Sunbury is well provided with hotel room and Mr. Dildine is making arrangements with the hotels, but it will require a large number of private families to assist in housing and feeding the visitors, and it is his purpose to ascertain in advance the extent to which this private accommodation will be afforded. Of course this entertainment is not expected to be gratis. Those of our citizens who can assist in this way may communicate with Mr. Dildine or with J. B. Byrod, secretary of the Businessmen's Association.

The annual convention of the Patrons of Husbandry is greatly enjoyed by them, pleasure and business being combined in its observance. The purpose of the Grange is to dignify labor. There are those in the organization that would like to see a practical application of the scriptural mandate. "If any man will not work, (doing something that the world needs to have done), neither let him eat."

The most bitter opponent of the Initiative and Referendum would hardly claim that were his principle in force in Philadelphia the Councils of that city would not have thought it worth while to give over a public franchise for seventy-five years to a priavte corporation as they did lately in voting for the lease of the gas works.

Great Demand For Rural Delivery.

According to tables prepared in the division of rural free delivery, which have just been laid before Postmaster General Cortelyou by the Fourth Assistant Postmaster General, there is no preceptible abatement in the demand for the rural free delivery service. There are pending 4,708 petitions for new service, against 5,470 similiar petitions on file one year ago.

The work of establishing the service is proceeding as rapidly as possible. Rural routes are being ordered into effect at an average rate of about six hundred a month. With the beginning of the next fiscal year, July 1, when the new appropriation for rural free delivery becomes effective, a large number of routes will be established, the service to start on August 1. It is found necessary to give at least sixty days notice of the intention to start a new service.

new York has 1,630 active routes, many counties being entirely covered by the service. Only seventy-eight petitions from that State are now pending.

The greatest pressure for the continuation and extension of the service comes from the Southern States.
