Must Have a Label.

The last Legislature so amended the law regulating the sale of concentrated commercial feeding stuffs as to add to the feeds that shall not be sold without having affixed thereto in a conspicuous place a legible and plainly printed statement certifying the number of net pounds of the feeding stuff the package contains, the name, brand or trademark under which the article is sold, the name and address of the manufacturer or importer, and a statement of the percentage it contains of crude fat and crude protein of the following: Corn bran, wheat, rye and buckwheat bran and middlings. Also hay, straw and corn stover, when the same are mixed with other materials. In other words, the feeds above named have been added to the list of feeds that cannot be sold without the above cited certificate being attached. This, however, does not, under the provisions of the act, interfere with persons engaged within the State of Pennsylvania in manufacturing flours so as to prevent them from selling at the place where made their own manufacture of brans and middlings, without having the above named certificate attached.
