Massachusetts Federalism. The following resolutions, says the Buffalo Courier, have been passed by the Whig Legislature of Massachusetts and signed by the Governor. They are enough to stamp with eternal infamy and disgrace, those who have thus deliberately libeled their country—outraged every principle of truth, patriotism and justice—and taken up the cause of our national enemies.
