The capture of the 50 Americans Explained.

ASSISTANCE BY THE PEOPLE!

New York, Sept. 1, 8 A. M. The Empire City left Havana on the night of the 18th inst., two days after the Cherokee, whose previous accounts were by the way of New York.

SEVERAL BATTLES REPORTED—SUCCESS OF THE PATRIOTS.

As before stated, Gen Lopez landed with his forces about 50 miles eastward of Havana. A severe battle has been fought at Bahia Honda, 15 leagues from Havana, which proved equally fatal for the invaders.

THE EXECUTIONS.

The most painful and unprovoked act, the execution of 35 Americans, who were taken near Bahia Honda. They were in small boats at the time, and were taken to the shore, where they were immediately taken to one of the fortifications and there brutally murdered.

THE MARCH.

The most intense excitement prevailed at Havana. Gen Cancha has issued an order for the arrest of all persons who may be heard expressing an opinion in favor of the Spaniards.

HAVANA, August 16.

The fact is said that Gen. Manzanilla has been obliged to return to Santiago, abandoning the field of battle. Gen. Lora was confined to his quarters.

At 10 o'clock next day the Spanish troops attacked the fortress at Santiago, a small town, situated between Havana and Las Vegas.

Latest from Cuba.

New York, Sept. 2.

The following despatch came to hand this morning: The Schooner Merchant which left Havana on the 21st, has arrived at this port. She brings intelligence that Gen. Lopez was victorious in a battle fought on the 17th.

The schooner Cincinatti which arrived today from Havana, passed the war steamer Pizarro at sea. She reports that Lopez's party had swelled to 4000, and was within 14 hours of Havana.

The Washington Telegraph says arrangements are in progress to land 5000 men in Cuba shortly, under distinguished leaders.

Confirmation of the Above. The schooner Cincinatti which arrived today from Havana, passed the war steamer Pizarro at sea. She reports that Lopez's party had swelled to 4000, and was within 14 hours of Havana.

Contradictory. The Government has received despatches from New Orleans, dated yesterday (P. M.), which state that up to the 20th Lopez had scarcely been able to maintain himself.

By the schooner Merchant, letters have been received from some of the principal mercantile houses of Havana, which contradict entirely the reported success of Lopez, as stated in the verbal accounts by the Merchant.

The New York papers received here for a week past, contain the most reliable intelligence of the Cuban revolt. They describe as dead New Orleans, and are not worthy of credit, and in some cases, dark falsehoods.

The advice by the Cincinatti which arrived yesterday are very conflicting. One account states that the Government had offered a reward to Lopez and agreed to pardon him if he would surrender.

The Traveller has a despatch stating that 69 towns have elected 45 whigs and 20 opposition members of the Legislature. There is no doubt of the Legislature being whig.
