SUNBURY & ERIE RAILROAD CONVENTION.

From the Pennsylvania. This body met yesterday morning in the Sansom Street Hall, and organized temporarily by calling Mayor Gillin to the chair.

On motion, the following named gentlemen were appointed to select officers for a permanent organization of the Convention: J. T. Bailey, of Philadelphia; J. L. Gillis, of Elk; John Galbraith, of Erie; Wm. A. Irvine, of Warren; and James Wilson, of Lehigh.

On motion, the following named gentlemen were appointed a committee on resolutions: Hon. G. W. Woodrow, Hon. M. D. Kelley, John Galbraith, T. S. Shaver, J. P. Coker, Wm. B. Reed, Thomas Chambers, and Hugh Bellas.

A letter was read from the Hon. James Buchanan, in which he expressed his regret at his inability to be present, and spoke in strong terms of the importance of the work for which the Convention has assembled.

A letter of a similar character was received from E. Banks. These letters were ordered to be published in the Convention.

James L. Gillis, of Elk, was then called upon to address the Convention, but he excused himself by reason of indisposition.

Mr. Biddle, of New York, was called upon to make a statement of the New York and Erie Railroad. He stated that during the month of September the Dunkirk and Piermont Railroad had yielded a revenue of \$200,000.

Mr. Charles B. Penrose also addressed the meeting in a very interesting speech. He stated that the Convention was organized by appointing the following officers:
