Bradford Girl's Suicide.

Nellie Reilly of Bradford, committed suicide at Buffalo, Nov. 8. This young lady had a lover who died, and this in connection with ill health is believed to have effected her mind. She went to Buffalo and registered at a hotel as Helen Russell, of Chicago, and was given a room. The following day she was found by the hotel people. She was sitting in a chair when found and a bottle of poison had done the work. All trace of the girl's identity had been destroyed by her suicide. Rosary beads were there to show that she had prayed before she died. The fact that she wore shoes made by a Bradford firm led to the belief that the corpse might be that of Miss Reilly. The aged mother of the girl went to Buffalo, but being old and not acute did not recognize the corpse as that of her daughter. A brother-in-law, of Elmira, N. Y., identified the body. The remains were taken to the home of her mother at Bradford and buried on Monday.
