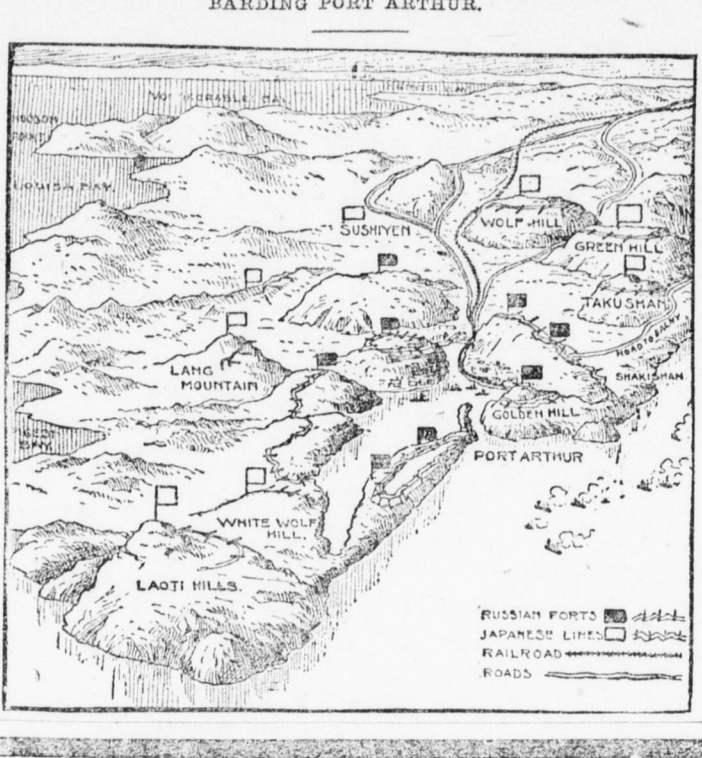

BULLETINS OF THE FAR EAST STRUGGLE

JAPS CAPTURE 'CHAIR FORT.' London, Aug. 24.—The Evening News publishes a dispatch from Che Foo under Tuesday's date announcing that the Japanese captured 'Chair fort,' of the Port Arthur defenses, Monday, after a tremendous attack.

RUSSIAN BOAT DISABLED. London, Aug. 25.—The correspondent of the Times at Shanghai, in a dispatch dated August 24, 11:35 p. m., says that orders from Emperor Nicholas have been conveyed to Capt. Reitzenstein commanding him forthwith to disarm the cruiser Askold and the torpedo boat destroyer Grozovoi, and that "the flags on both vessels were lowered at 7 o'clock to-night."

STRUCK FLOATING MINES. Tokio, Aug. 26.—Five steamers and three torpedo boat destroyers emerged from Port Arthur Wednesday morning and began the work of clearing away floating mines.

REFUSE TO ARBITRATE. Packing House Owners Decline to Negotiate with Strikers. Chicago, Aug. 27.—The conferences of the committee appointed earlier in the week to attempt a settlement of the stock yards strike with the parties to the dispute resulted in nothing.

Warning to Federal Officeholders. Washington, Aug. 27.—In view of the approaching election the civil service commission has addressed a letter to the heads of all government departments calling their attention to violations of the civil service law which have occurred in the past in connection with political campaigns.

Laney's Pal Is Arrested. Augusta, Ga., Aug. 26.—A special to the Herald from Rome, Ga., says Dick Brook, the alleged partner of Joe Laney, jr., was arrested there Thursday.

Spent 40 Minutes Under Water. Newport, R. I., Aug. 25.—It became known yesterday that while the submarine torpedo boat Shark was being prepared for a submerged run near Brenton's Reef lightship Monday afternoon she sank to the bottom in a hundred feet of water and remained there for some time before the crew could move her.

Golden Hill, White Marble mountain and Laoti mountain, according to Chinese advices dated the night of August 22, are now the only main forts securely held by the Russians at Port Arthur.

A junk which left Port Arthur August 22 reports that the Russian wounded at that date numbered 5,000 and that the Japanese occupied the heights near Chaochanko.

Admiral Kataoka reports that the Japanese cruisers Nisshin and Kasuga fired upon the Russian forts on Tuesday. They discovered that the Russians were shelling the Japanese land forces. The Nisshin and the Kasuga steamed in close to land and after a short bombardment silenced the Russian guns.

Japanese here expect that their army may even enter the residence and business district of Port Arthur, but that this would not necessarily mean the fall of the Russian stronghold. The Russian defenses are arranged with the idea of resisting as long as a man is left.
