THE IMPORTANCE OF PRESENCE OF MIND.—1. If a man faints, place him flat on his back and let him alone.

2. If any poison is swallowed, drink instantly half a glass of cool water, with a teaspoonful of each of common salt and ground mustard stirred into it.

3. The best thing to stop the bleeding of a moderate cut, instantly, is to cover it profusely with cobweb, or flour and salt, half and half.

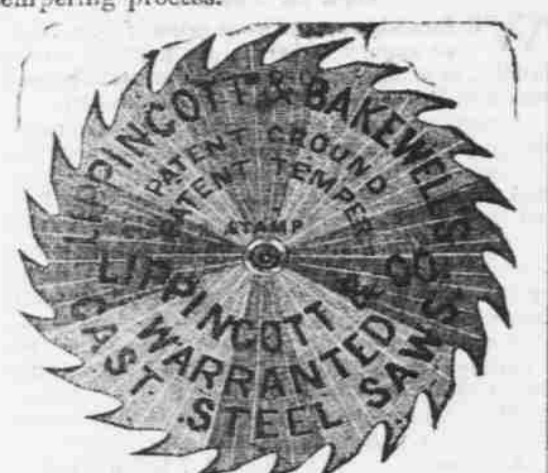
4.
