Large Increase of the National Debt in July. — The official statement of the public debt has just been published. It shows an increase, during the month of July, of thirteen million, two hundred and fifty-eight thousand, five hundred and nine dollars and ninety three cents.

THE PUBLIC DEBT.

THE SHARE OF EACH COUNTY IN PENNSYLVANIA, AND THE INTEREST THEREON.

The following table setting forth the pro rata share of the public debt, and of the yearly interest thereon, to be paid by each county in this State, has been prepared with much care, and may be considered reliable.

Table with columns: Each county's share of the principal of the public debt, Each county's share of the interest of public debt, and County names including Adams, Allegheny, Armstrong, Beaver, Bedford, Berks, Blair, Bradford, Bucks, Butler, Cambria, Carbon, Chester, Columbia, Davidson, Delaware, Erie, Elk, Fayette, Franklin, Fulton, Greene, Huntingdon, Indiana, Jefferson, Juniata, Lancaster, Lebanon, Lehigh, Luzerne, Lycoming, Mercer, Mifflin, Monroe, Montgomery, Northampton, Northumberland, Perry, Philadelphia, Pike, Potter, Schuylkill, Snyder, Somerset, Sullivan, Susquehanna, Tazewell, Union, Venango, Warren, Washington, Wayne, Westmoreland, Wyoming, York.

It should be remembered that this does not include pensions, bounties, and debts of a similar description. Is it not amazing to contemplate the sum which are gathered from the people, year after year, simply to pay the interest on this debt? People often complain of their county and State taxes, but in hardly any county in the Commonwealth do these amount to one-tenth of the interest actually paid on the public debt each year by the people of such county.
