Dear Freeman.—The excitement incident to the near approach of the election is growing intense. Both parties are straining every nerve in view of the close contest for Congress in this district.

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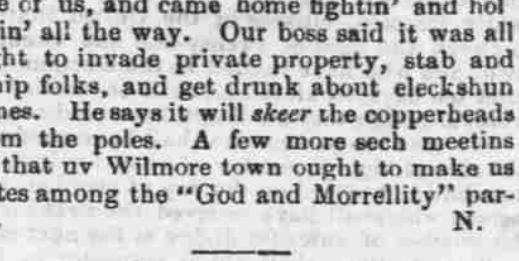
