

England was often supplied with this choice dainty by the fishermen of Normandy, who made it an article of commerce. The Normans had various ways of cocking it; sometimes it was roasted and brought to the table or a spit; but the usual way was to boil it and serve it with peas. Epicures looked out for a slice from the tongue or tail. The grampus or the sea-wolf was also highly esteemed ; but of the blubber dainties the porpoise was deemed the most savory.
