The vote in Connecticut was rather above the average on Governor—being the largest since 1871. It amounted to 91,112, divided as follows: Ingersoll, Democrat, 47,744; Harrison, Republican, 40,412; Smith, Prohibitionist, 4,286—the largest vote cast by that party for a number of years.
