

The State House - 1776 - 1876

The erection of this edifice was begun in 1729 and completed in 1734. The two wings were added in 1737-'40, and it was then one of the largest and most costly edifices for civil purposes in America.

The interior decorations remain as originally designed, and for the production of so early a time, are very fine; and those of the main hall, embracing a richly paneled ceiling and a heavy cornice supported by fluted columns, will strike the eye as exceedingly beautiful.

The Hall still presents, as far as has been possible to retain it, its appearance. The portraits of the signers embellish the walls, perpetuating not only the face of those historic men, but the skill of Peale, Stuart, Inman, and Sully.

Upon the second floor are two chambers now used by Select and Common Councils, the westernmost being formerly the Senate hall of the first Congress.
