QUININE—TREES THAT PRODUCE IT.

Quinine, which is a prepared form of Peruvian bark, is used to combat malarious fevers.

The first use of the bark is said to have been in the case of the Countess of Chinchon, wife of the Viceroy of Peru, who was cured of fever by it in 1638.

The Jesuit missionaries quickly became aware of its properties, and used it so constantly as a medicine that it received the name of Jesuits' bark. The original Indian name, Kinskina, gave place in Peru to that of Caspia, or Fever tree.
