USEFUL HINTS.

To soften the hard, dry putty in the window sash it will muriatic acid. Oxalic acid will remove stains of ink and iron rust, but must not be allowed to stand long on the goods or paint.

To take the woody taste out of a wooden pail, fill the pail with boiling hot water; let it remain until cool, then empty it and dissolve some soda in lukewarm water, adding a little lime to it, and wash the inside well with the solution; after that, scald with hot water and rinse well.

To remove spots from furniture, take four ounces of vinegar, two of sweet oil, and one of turpentine; mix and apply with flannel cloth.

To clean walling wash with a solution of a pint of salt to five gallons of water, and wipe dry immediately.

To clean oilcloths, wash always with warm water. Wash the cloths with hot water and soap, dry thoroughly and apply a coat of varnish. They will last as long again.

To give glass great brilliancy, wash with soap suds, then with a solution of two ounces of white vitriol to four gallons of water. Sift a quarter of a pound of white vitriol into a bushel of fine sand, mix and place in a tin pail, cover with fresh water, and set the pail in a kettle of boiling water.

To clean white walls, scrape off all old whitewash, then wash with a solution of two ounces of white vitriol to four gallons of water.
