ever invented one of the damaging charges against Garfield which are now denounced by the Republican press as "Democratic lies?" Not one. It was the Poland committee, composed of a majority of Republicans (Poland, Banks and McCrary), who made their report to the House in 1873 charging Garfield with having been bribed by Oakes Ames with Credit Mobilier stock, amounting to \$1,000. His own Republican constituents at a district convention held at Warren, Trembly county, Ohio, in September, 1876, arraigned and denounced him, in the seventh resolution adopted by them, "for his corrupt connection with the Credit Mobilier." The New York Tribune and New York Times, then as now the leading Republican papers of the country, denounced him together with the others who had taken shares of the same stock, and held him up to the scorn and contempt of the people. And so in regard to Garfield's sale of his official influence, as chairman of the appropriation committee, to the Delaney pavement company for the sum of \$5,000, the payment of the money having been admitted by Garfield himself in his testimony before a Congressional committee, Garfield stands condemned, not by "Democratic lies," but by his own party friends in Congress, by a convention of his own Republican constituents, and by the leading organs of the Republican party.

REPUBLICAN EDITORS HAVING DISCOVERED from their brief, but bitter experience, that the military as well as the civil record of Gen. Hancock is absolutely unassailable, and that in their attacks upon it they have simply been gnawing at a file, have turned their batteries against Wm. H. English, the candidate for Vice President. Because Mr. English had made money, which he had honestly earned, to lean on mortgage to persons for building purposes, or making other improvements, and because after it became due and remained unpaid he resorted to legal proceedings to get what was his own, he has been charged with extortion and held up as an oppressor. If one man borrows money from another he must repay it according to the contract, and if he neglects or refuses to do so he must be compelled to do it. Every good business man in the country acts upon this principle, and Mr. English has never speculated on his debtors' misfortunes, as has been distinctly certified by Mr. English's two agents in attending to such matters for him, both of whom state that they are Republicans. It is creditable to the Indianapolis State Journal, the leading Republican paper in Indiana, that it refuses to publish the violent attacks which have been made against Mr. English as a mortgagee, or to sanction any imputation upon his high character for honesty and integrity.

THE RESULT OF THE ARIZONA ELECTION, which took place last Monday, was just as every sane man believed it would be, viz: the success of the Democratic State ticket by a majority of about 30,000. There was no Republican ticket in the field, but notwithstanding that trifling circumstance the organs of that party in the North will raise the old and stale cry of intimidation and fraud in the count. The Albany Tribune will roll the result under its tongue as a sweet morsel showing Democrat devilry in all its blackest forms, and by next Monday, if it is in its usual luck, will have made the discovery that Arkansas, like Alabama, has its friends in Congress, where every colored man would be hounded with a noose or a halibut gun as he approached the polls. An amendment to the constitution repudiating a part of the State debt contracted under carpet-bag rule was voted on by the people, and it is gratifying to know, was defeated, judging from the puffed faith of the State is due to Gen. A. H. Garland, a United States Senator from Arkansas. WHEN ONE MEMBER OF CONGRESS undertakes to "borrow" money from another member of Congress he should be very careful to borrow in round sums, say \$200, \$500, \$1,000, and not that amount, \$329, the sum for which Oakes Ames gave a check to Garfield, which the latter, after the Credit Mobilier business had begun to be talked about, wanted Ames to consider as "a loan."

THE POLAND COMMITTEE, however, after Garfield had sworn before to the following effect: "I never owned, received or agreed to receive any stock of the Credit Mobilier, or of the Union Pacific Railroad, nor any dividends or profits arising from either of them," had no difficulty, after all the evidence had been heard, in accounting for the manner in which Garfield happened to get just \$329, neither more nor less, from Ames, and Garfield had understood that Ames explained the matter as follows:

"The fact in regard to Mr. Garfield, as found by the committee, was that he agreed with Ames to take ten shares of Credit Mobilier stock, but did not pay for the same. Ames received the eighty per cent dividend in bonds and then for eighty-seven per cent, and also received the sixty per cent, cash dividend, which together with the price of stock and interest, had a balance of \$329. This sum was paid over to Mr. Garfield by a check on the regional arms and Mr. Garfield had understood that Ames used the balance of dividends after paying for the stock."
