Constipation may be removed by drinking a tumbler of cold water on rising in the morning. To obtain a good night's sleep, sponge the entire length of the spine with hot water for ten or lifteen minutes. For neuralgia, take a good handful of common field or Canada thistle, pour two quarts of boiling water on, and boil down to three pints ; take a wineglassful three times a day before meals. Poison from bees, hornets, spider bites, etc., is instantly arrested by the application of equal parts of common phia, Pa.) salt and bicarbonate of soda, well rub-bed in on the place bitten or stung. A small piece of rosin, dipped in the water which is placed in a vessel on a stove, will add a peculiar property to the atmosphere of the room, which will give great relief to persons troubled with cough. rosin. The following is recommended as a cure for neuralgic headache : Squeeze the juice of a lemon into a small cup of strong coffee. This will asually afford immediate relief in neuralgic headache. Tea ordinarily increases neuralgic pain. and ought not to be used by persons affected with it.

A correspondent writes to the Cincinnati Enquirer : The following remedy for corns I have never known to fail : Take sassafras oil and spirits turpentine -equal parts. Shave the corn down as thin as possible; then shake the mixture well and rub before going to bed. Do this for three or four nights or more. To cure rheumatism, boil a small handful of lobelia in a half pint of water, till the strength is out of the herb, then strain it off and add a teaspoonful of fine salt. Wring cloths out of the liquid as hot as possible, and spread them over the part affected. It acts like a charm. Change the cloths as soon as cold till the pain is all gone; vent taking cold. then cover the place with a soft dry covering, till perspiration is over, to pre-





If cabbage can be procurhas ceased to be pleased with "boughten" things. If cabbage can be procured a really good pickle can be made with it. Here are two rules : Slice and boil until tender three heads of cabbage. as for coldslaw; add a little salt and vinegar to the water in which they are boiled. When done take out and spread on plates and drain off the vinegar and water. Then put in a jar and pour warm, fresh vinegar over. Sweeten to taste ; celery seed and mustard are good to season with. For the other kind of pickle select a nice firm head of cabbage. After removing the outside leaves, and inspecting it carefully to see that there


