On the other hand, do we not know of a journal whose whole tone, in editorials, in news and news-comment, in political discussion, in literary review - is the tone of cordial talk between gentlemen?

It is plain to every one that each writer is offering, not a second-rate intellect, but a second-rate intellect or inferior opportunities, but the best knowledge and opinion by him attainable.

The "power of the press" - we are always indulging as one of our boasted modern blessings. Yet in any own private judgment I think the liberty of thinking that the best newspaper affectioned has done more harm in this country in the past dozen years than any other one indulgence.
