Communication. BUTTE CITY, Montana, May 13, 1888. EDITOR FREEMAN:—According to promise, I will give you a history of my experience in this place and of my journey here. I left Pittsburgh on the 30th of April, and, with the exception of a slight experience in a railroad wreck at Norwalk, Ohio, had a pleasant trip, arriving here on the 8th of May.

"All is not gold that glitters," and despite the fact that before my coming work was said to be plenty, on my arrival I found there were about six men for every job. The wages are good—\$2.50, \$3.00 and \$3.50 per day for miners.

It is a lively town—every third or fourth house is a store or saloon. I have not seen a foot of ground under cultivation and I have been around considerable. As I write (Sunday) the blacksmith across the street is hammering away the same as on week days. Sundays are not kept and morals are at a low ebb. Gambling, day and night is going on without intermission from one week's end to another. Drunkenness is as universal as the air, and the great object of the blacksmith's trade.

There are people here from all parts of the world, all trying to get ahead of each other. There is no "neighbor" in this country. Every man is for himself and must take care of himself. Truly Yours, ...
