

THE OLD SHIP PROGRESS.

An Interesting Exhibit for the Great World's Fair.

A Brief History of the Thrilling Adventures Through the Storms of the Old Whaling Vessel Hus.

A most interesting exhibit intended for the world's fair has recently arrived in the city. The "Progress," a small vessel used in whaling, is now on an exhibit at the fair.

The "Progress" has been what is known among whalers as a "hobby" ship. Built in 1841, it started on its first voyage around Cape Horn to the Sandwich Islands and north to the Arctic seas in 1841, during the war.

Among its adventures, which are well related in one that occurred in 1841, was the capture of a whale.
