

REFORMERS BEATEN.

Their Tickets Lose in Philadelphia and Pittsburgh.

THE QUAY MEN VOTED STRAIGHT.

They Failed to Support the Ticket of the Municipal League in the Quaker City.

PHILADELPHIA, Feb. 19.

The returns from the contested wards in this city indicate that the municipal league has failed in its effort to secure the election of a committee of reformers.

In the Eighth ward, where a hard fight was made against Wences Hartman, who is president of common councils, that gentleman was elected by nearly 1,000 majority.

In the 12th ward a bitter fight was waged against James B. Anderson, whose course in select council for years past has displeased the reformers.

Edward A. Devlin, Republican and Mayor E. W. Moore, Democrat, were elected magistrates, the latter under the law relating to minority representation.

The campaign was noteworthy for the especially bitter fights in many of the wards, and to the fact that in the Republican ranks, the efforts of the municipal league and here and there to the aid of the Democratic ticket.

A municipal election, when a mayor is not to be chosen, is usually marked by a light vote. In 17 out of the 37 wards, voting to elect a mayor was between rival candidates for select and common council an unusually heavy vote.

The Democratic ticket was elected in Allegheny as was practically no opposition.

ALTOONA.—Returns indicate the election of Mayor C. J. Schick, Democrat, and Nicholson, Democrat, for controller, over Barr and Harpam, Republicans.

CHAMBERSBURG.—The Democrats elected George C. Cooke, borough auditor, although the nominal Republican ticket was elected by a majority of 285 votes.

BEAVER FALLS.—The Republican city ticket was elected.

LEWISBURG.—The whole Democratic ticket was elected.

OVER FIFTY PERISHED.

A Fearful Gas Explosion Occurs in a Colorado Mine.

NEW CASTLE, Col., Feb. 19.—An explosion has occurred at the Vulcan mine which was the most disastrous ever known in the history of this camp, and dozens of homes in this little city are desolated.

The force of the explosion caused a cavern, and the tunnel and air courses were filled with the fallen rock, earth and timber. Both fan houses were wrecked and the slope and vicinity was full of debris and the gas was so bad that it was very dangerous work to begin the rescue.

The construction of a temporary fan-house was commenced at once, and the mine will soon begin. It is hardly possible that any of the miners are still alive, but the starting of the fans will be to ascertain if any have survived.

It is thought the disaster may have been caused by the breaking into an immense pocket of gas, which was ignited by the electric light.

THE MISSING TURN UP.
