BIG FIRE AT MIRAGOANE.

Five Thousand Persons Homeless—
Loss \$1,000,000.

New York April 4.—Miragoane was destroyed by fire on the 16th of March. The Haytian government is sending relief. Five or six thousand persons have been rendered homeless. The property destroyed included 50,000 bags of coffee, 1,800,000 pounds of logwood of which 800,000 pounds were to have been shipped to France and the remainder to New York. The loss is about \$1,000,000.

HAD TWINS AT SIXTY.

The process of leveling the ground for a central railway terminus at Strasburg has led to the discovery of very many stone coffins, evidently dating from the Roman period, a discovery which confirms the belief long entertained that this place was the site of a Roman burial ground. Canon Straub, the president of the local historical society, who takes a great interest in all such matters, has obtained from the military authorities the assistance of several pioneers, and is making much deeper excavations at the new central station in the hope of laying bare the whole plan of the Roman cemetery and of discovering some objects of special interest to antiquaries.
