—DIPATHERIA.—Dr. Gauthier. of St. Paul, Minn., tells in the Chicago Medical Review of his success in an epidemic of diphtheria by the use of iodine. He has treated 200 cases with but two deaths, while before adopting this method he lost one-third of all his cases. The treatment is as follows: The patient is ordered fincture iodine in ten to twelve drop doese every hour, well diluted with water, so long as fever lasts, subsequently reducing to ten drops every two, and finally every three hours.
