Section I.—The try and all persons en-

gaged in the business of brewing or manufacture of ale, beer or other malt liquors, or in the fermentation, distillation or man afacture of any vinous or spirituous liqurar, he and they are heraby prohibited making use is sea bout such business or in any auch process of browing, fermentation, distribution or manufacture of any poisonous or deleterious denge or chemicals or any impure or injurious materials or such as are prejudicial to the public health or to the health of any person drinking or making use of any such malt, to get rid of stock, vinous or spirituous liquors.
