### TWO BILLS WHICH HAVE BEEN SIGNED BY THE GOVERNOR.

No More Pool or Other Game of Chance to be Played for Drinks.

The following are two full texts of two important bills which have been passed both branches of the legislature and have been signed by the Governor Hoyt.

Section 1—That if the proprietor, keeper, lessee or manager of any saloon, hotel, tavern, billiard room or other place of resort or entertainment shall keep, maintain, or permit to be played upon his premises, or in connection therewith, or having passage for communication to or with the same, the game or amusement of pool with balls or any other game of chance, the result or price of forfeiture of payment in any form of such game or amusement shall be by drinks, of yinow, spirituous, malt or brewed liquors or any admixture thereof, and he shall be guilty of misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be sentenced for the first offense to pay a fine of one hundred dollars and to undergo an imprisonment of not less than ninety days, and for the second offense to pay a fine of five hundred dollars and to undergo an imprisonment of not less than one year; and any license granted for the keeping of such saloon, hotel, tavern, inn, billiard room or other place of resort or amusement shall, upon such second conviction, be declared null and void by the court in which the said second offense shall be tried. Approved June 1, A. D. 1881.

Section 2—That any and all persons engaged in the business of brewing or manufacture of ale, beer or other malt liquors, or in the fermentation, distillation or manufacture of any vinous or spirituous liquors, be and they are hereby prohibited making any false statement or business or in any such process of brewing, fermentation, distillation or manufacture of any poisonous or deleterious drugs or chemicals or any impure or injurious materials or such as are prejudicial to the public health or to the health of any person drinking or making use of any such malt, vinous or spirituous liquors.

Section 3—That the use of any such poisonous or deleterious drugs or chemicals or impure or injurious materials or of those prejudicial to health as are prohibited by the first section of this act is hereby declared to be a misdemeanor and any person convicted of so using the same shall be punished by a fine of one thousand dollars and by an imprisonment of not less than one year. Approved June 2, 1881.

Section 4—The very best canned corn, peaches, tomatoes, etc., in the market at Dinges'. Give them a trial and you will use no other.

Section 5—We almost had a row in town the other day. Two men met on the street and No. 1 called No. 2 some hard names. when No. 2 replied by telling No. 1 to go to—Lewins for cheap clothing, as that was the only responsible clothing house in this part of the state. Happily this calmed No. 1, and what might have been a serious difficulty proved a blessing, for No. 1 is now buying his clothing at the Philad. Branch.
