Sketch of the Life of the Murdered President. James Abram Garfield was born in the township of Orange, Cayuga county, N. Y., on the 19th of November, 1829.

Sketch of the Life of the New President. Chester Alan Arthur was born in Franklin county, Vermont, on the 5th of October, 1829.

When he recovered, he postponed his completion of the course at the high school in March, 1848, he entered Georgia academy, a high school in Georgia, where he had saved a small sum of money, which he gave to him when he started for his college.

By the summer of 1854 Governor Garfield, then twenty-three years old, had procured his studies as far as the academy of his native country could carry him.

On his return to his native country, Mr. Garfield was made teacher of Latin and Greek in the Hiram Normal Institution.

In 1852, at the age of twenty-three, he was elected to the State senate from the district embracing Portage and Summit counties.

The military services of General Garfield were recognized by the appointment of the rank of major-general in the regular army.

In 1877, General Garfield was the Republican candidate for the presidency, but the Democrats were largely in the majority, and Mr. Hancock was elected.
