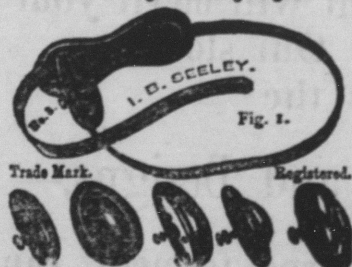

Rodgers after having established Wrangle Land to be an island steamed 121 miles north and northwest in search of further land, but failed to find any. Lieut.
