**ICEBERGS COMING SOUTH.**

St. Johns, N. F., Oct. 29.—Two vast islands of ice are visible in the offing, driving rapidly southward. At sunrise this morning these huge bergs were not discernable within the range of the horizon. Their great draft rate may be deducted from the fact that about half an hour before sunset they bore, the one southeast by south from the north head of the harbor of St. Johns, and the other south by southeast. They were then distant thirty and thirty-two miles respectively, the northern one being most distant from the land. This berg is about fifteen hundred feet in length, about one hundred and twenty feet in average height, and has two spires surmounting it that soar not less than one hundred and fifty feet above the general level of the ice island. The more southern berg is about eight hundred feet in length and its general front elevation is somewhat less than one hundred feet. One portion rises 120 feet above the body of the main berg. The place from which the above observation was made is located 627 feet above the sea level. The approximate draft rate of these icebergs is two and a quarter miles per hour. Before this dispatch is printed in the *Herald* the resistless floating monsters will have begun to cut their way at right angles through the track of ocean commerce, hurrying night and day on the North Atlantic, between the Old and New worlds.

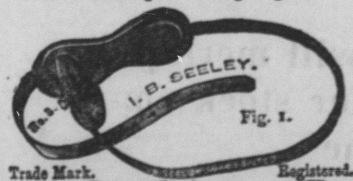

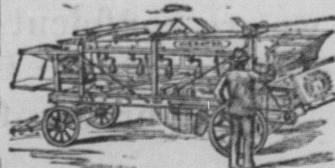
