Buffalo, N. Y., Nov 21.-Detective W. Y. Lyon, of Reading, Pa., arrived at this city to-day from Cass county, Michigan, having in charge Uriah Moyer, charged with complicity in the murder of J. and Rachel Kintzler, an old couple, at Troxellville, Pa. Three of the conspirators are now under sentence to be hanged December 16 next, and in confessing the crime implicated Uriah Moyer as the one who shot the old man.

THE NATIONAL BANKS.

During the year fifty-four national banks were organized and twenty went into voluntary liquidation, leaving 2,136 doing business at the close of the year. No national bank failed during the year. The semi-annual duty accruing from national banks during the year was \$8,493,552 55, making the total amount collected since the establishment of the national banking system in 1863, \$108,855,021.90. At the close of the year there was held by the Treasurer in United States bonds \$360,505,900 as security for the circulation of national banks and \$15,293,500 as security for public deposits in national bank depositories. During the year \$276,899,700 in bonds was deposited for these purposes, and \$277,527,350 withdrawn, exceeding by far the transactions of any former year. These changes were chiefly due to the continuance of the five and six per cent. bonds at 3 1/2 per cent. and by the substitution of the continued bonds for four and four and a half per cent.

The United States currency outstanding was \$362,589,437.65. There was redeemed \$71,069,974.95, making the total redemptions since the first issue of currency, \$2,300,141,073.36.

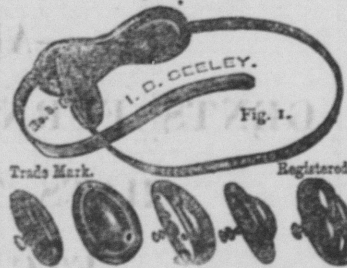
