### WHAT SMOKING DOES FOR BOYS.

A certain doctor, struck with the large number of boys under the age of fifteen years whom he observed smoking, was led to inquire into the effect the habit had upon their general health, says the *British Medical Journal*. He took for this purpose thirty-eight boys, aged from nine to fifteen years, and carefully examined them, and in twenty-seven of them he found injurious traces of the habit. In twenty-two there were various disorders of the circulation and digestion, palpitation of the heart, and more or less marked taste for strong drink. In twelve there was frequent bleeding of the nose; ten had disturbed sleep, and twelve had slight ulceration of the mucous membrane of the mouth, which disappeared on ceasing from the use of tobacco for some days. Medical treatment was of little use till the smoking was discontinued, when health and strength were soon restored. This is no "old woman's story." The facts are of good authority.

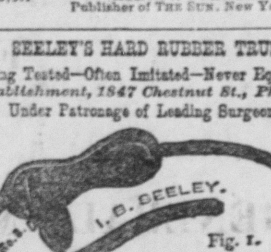
