BY RAIL TO MEXICO.

Laredo, December 15.—The track-layers of the Missouri, Kansas and Texas extension completed the laying of the line to the limits of this city to-day. This gives an unbroken direct line of railway from the Mississippi at St. Louis to the Rio Grande at Laredo, making a through line of about 1,300 miles in length. The Southwestern system undertaken by Mr. Gould a little more than a year ago has now been completed from the Mississippi at St. Louis to three points—New Orleans, near the Gulf; El Paso, on the frontier of New Mexico, and Laredo, about half-way between these two.

Mexico is now reached by an American railway line. The construction forces of the system are now rapidly concentrating at this point to commence the great work of pushing on 700 miles further to the City of Mexico. The engineers who have had this part of the work in charge have completed their preliminary report. It is very favorable. The line will run through a rich mining and agricultural country. Extensive deposits of coal have been found on the road, and such arrangements are making that a standard-gauge railway line to be operated by the Missouri Pacific Company from St. Louis through the City of Mexico, 2,000 miles in length, may be expected to be completed and in operation in eighteen months from this time.

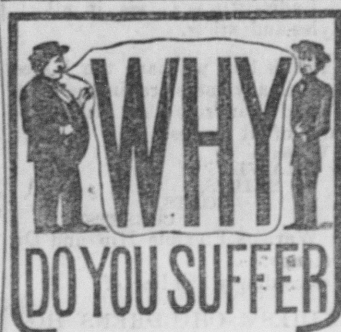
