#### THE SUFFERING OF THE PERSECUTED JEWS.

Vienna, May 6.—The reports of horri-  
ble outrages perpetrated on the unfortu-  
nate Jews of Balta and Hozolo which  
reach us are almost incredible. Moved by  
these reports the wealthy Jews of Vienna  
are coming to the aid of their brethren  
generously. An Austrian physician, who  
visited a Jewish hospital in Odessa where  
about 150 victims of Balta were received,  
tells us that their wailings and cries are  
unendurable. The one year-old baby of  
one young woman who had suffered ex-  
treme violence herself had both his eyes  
put out by a heated iron. The incensed  
husband drew a revolver to protect his  
wife and child, but he was bound and car-  
ried off, his young wife being kept in ig-  
norance of his fate. An old woman was  
accused for hiding her grandchildren,  
and when the children were found they  
were cut to pieces before her eyes. A  
child of six had her ears cut off for run-  
ning away with her baby sister and died  
soon afterwards. In one room of the hos-  
pital was an old man whose arms had  
been thrice broken while he was tied to a  
pole opposite his house and made a wit-  
ness to the burning of its flames of his  
wife and children. Another man had both  
his feet sawn off and thrown to the dogs in  
his presence.

It appears in all that there are 3000  
children who by these atrocities have  
been deprived of their parents. Although  
subscriptions are being raised in all quar-  
ters there are not means enough to pro-  
vide for these poor creatures with the  
very first necessities of life. Many of  
them are to emigrate to America, and a  
proposal has been made for sending them  
to the fertile districts of Palestine. But it  
is said the Turkish Government does not  
favor this plan. In many parts of Russia  
the ruffins, when they have finished mas-  
sacring the Jews, begin on the German  
colonists. The police, in some cases, have  
made common cause with the rioters in-  
stead of trying to stop them.
