NIHILIST WARNING.

London, March 20, 1883 .- The Gover, nor of Moscow has received a letter warning him that the Kremlin, where the Czar is to be crowned, will be blown up during the coronation cerimony if the Czar refuses to grant a constitution. Two dynamite depots have been dis-covered in St Petersburg. Forty persons were arrested yesterday. The week's arrests number 200, including pupils of the military schools and railway officials. The government has resolved to expel all Italians who are without permanent oc-

cupation. The Chronicle's St Petersburg despatch says a student who attembted to commit utcide while in a bath last month has confessed that the nihilist commanded him to shoot the Czar at the banquet and fete given by the Finland regiment. The student was present at the banquet disguised as a waiter. His courage failed him at the last moment, and knowing his fate from the nihilists, he resolved to commit suicide.


