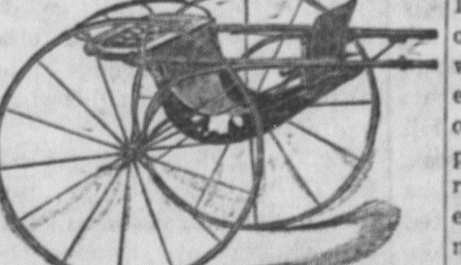

**THE RELATION OF S. S. TRAINING TO NATIONAL AND SOCIAL LIFE.**

The most enthusiastic advocate of the Sabbath School cause will not claim that it can be Utopian in its results, national or social—correcting all short-comings and rendering the government and society faultless in religion, morality and politics. But that the good effects of Sabbath school training do manifest themselves in a very marked degree in a wisely-governed nation and in wholesome influences upon society, can not be gained.  
We are taught that all good government is founded upon Justice. This must necessarily be so, for there can be no good where there is no justice. Justice is co-existent with the Divinity, and in the inspired Word we find it plainly expounded for our guidance in our relations to the government and society. No nation can long exist where the ways of Justice are departed from, and the social life will be fouled where there are not felt the preserving influences of a training in Christian ethics, without which there is no genuine happiness, and man falls short of his true mission.  
The Bible, then, being our teacher and guide in all that is just, pure and vital to a nation's welfare as well as in our social relations, the relation of its teachings—of which Sabbath school training solely consists—to National and social life are of prime importance. This fact we take to be established without further argument.

The source of Sabbath school training is from the Bible alone, which is the fountain of justice and purity, the two pillars upon which all civilized nations and societies of needs claim to be planted.  
If from this source be the training of the Sabbath school, then how clearly do we find in it the important relation it sustains to National and social life. We could here ask the question, What other training is paramount to this in its benefits to man in all his relations. There is none and there can be none. Justice and Godliness in the conduct of the nation and of men in social life are the essence of all happiness and well-being.  
These being the main teachings of the Bible, and the Bible being the only book from which our S. S. training is derived, we conclude that such culture is indispensable to National and social life. Its shining, fundamental qualities are a specialty in Sabbath school instruction—from thence they enter into the foundation of government and society. Therefore, when the young man has been trained in these nurseries of the Lord you have instilled in him the qualities he must possess of to make a good ruler, law-maker and faithful public servant; he will have been taught wisdom, honesty, justice, sobriety—all the qualities of a Christian—these only constitute him a valued, fit and safe member in society.

What would be thought of the city or neighborhood without a Sabbath school? Its morality would be at a discount; violation of the third commandment would be the rule, and its observance the exception; vice and crime the practice of the young followed by moral blood-poisoning at the age of manhood, to carry its evil influences into local and general government, debauching its civil administration; sowing seeds of discontent; causing anarchy and civil commotion—and ending in the downfall of the Nation and the uprooting of society. History furnishes proofs of the woe that inevitably follows a despising of the sublime training of our Sabbath schools; it also teaches of the happiness, prosperity and well-being and personal safety of that community where this training obtains.  
Our Sabbath school training is simply a continuation of the teaching of the early Christians which broke up the licentiousness of the theatre and the gladiatorial games under the sanction of the Roman empire, when emperor and subject found pleasure in the slaughter of men and tearing of animals in the arena of the amphitheatre. To these pagan practices the sanction of the government and populace might again be given if the teaching which led to their banishment were dispensed with. France tried it, and the history of the revolution of '98 tells with what result.  
Abolish the Sabbath school! The thought is at once shocking to every sane mind. We might endure it for a generation, but would a condition akin to that of the cities of the plains be farther removed? What would our own day lend to-day without the mighty influences of the Sabbath school? What safety and cherishing in social life?

The answer comes: Sabbath school training is a part of the life-blood of the nation and the conservator of all good society.—E. Kurtz at the L. Central Synod, S. S. A., Lock Haven.
