A PERILOUS TRIP.

**Terrible Experience of the Bark
"Chapman."**

HALIFAX, N. S., Sept. 11.—The bark Chapman, of Brahestad, Finland, which put in here, while on her voyage from Pensacola to Amsterdam, reports a terrible experience. The vessel sailed from Pensacola July 30, with a cargo of pitch pine timber. On the 28th of August stormy weather set in, and the following day the wind increased in fury, blowing a gale from east-southeast nearly all day. In the evening it became a hurricane, and a tremendous cross sea was running, frequently washing over the bark's bowsprit, which, with all attached to it, was carried away at the knight head, and shortly after the foremast went, breaking seven feet from the deck. The main topgallantmast and gear got under the ship's bottom, but was cut clear. The bulwarks on the port side and one boat were smashed. The topgallant yard was rigged for a jury mast, and the bark arrived off Halifax on Saturday, and was taken in tow by a steam tug yesterday.
