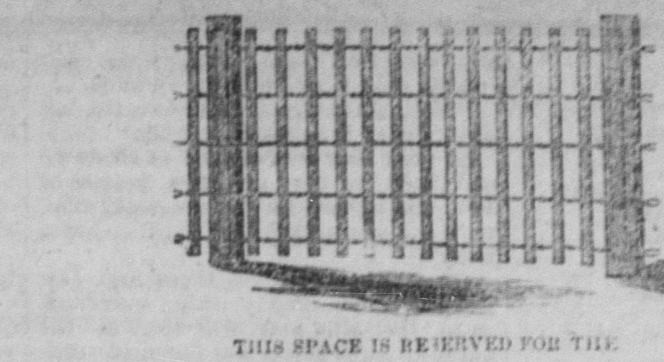
PENN CAVE HOUSE, FARMERS MILLS, PA.
