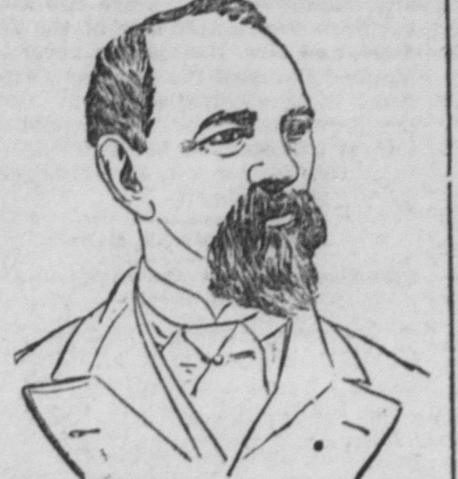
SUNSET COX RESIGNS.
